Looking to study in the UK?

Then you can take a LanguageCert SELT for Study in the UK exam to prove your Listening, Reading, Writing & Speaking skills in English. The level required depends on your exact visa type.

Which exam do I need to take?

Each visa application has a specific English language requirement set by the UK Home Office. Below you can find which LanguageCert SELT exam you will need to take based on the visa type you are applying for.

Application type	Minimum CEFR level required	Skills required	LanguageCert SELT exam
Student visa — below degree level	B1	Listening, Reading, Writing & Speaking	LanguageCert International ESOL SELT B1 (Listening, Reading, Writing & Speaking)
Student visa — degree level and above	B2	Listening, Reading, Writing & Speaking	LanguageCert International ESOL SELT B2 (Listening, Reading, Writing & Speaking)

Some institutions may require a level of English competence that is higher than the minimum UKVI study visa requirement, so before you plan your exam you should always check your sponsor’s English language level requirements. The following LanguageCert SELT exams are available and approved by UKVI.

The levels listed in the first table above are the minimum CEFR Listening, Reading, Writing & Speaking levels required for each visa type. If you achieve a higher-level Listening, Speaking & Listening exam than the minimum requirement, your result will then meet UKVI standards.
